Subject: **Membership of the Geneva Central Review Panel**

1. In accordance with the Secretary-General's bulletin ST/SGB/2011/7, the Central Review Panel at Geneva has been established. The membership of the Panel has been constituted from staff members elected by the staff and staff members selected by the Secretary-General.
